


## **LET'S MAKE:**

A paper chain caterpillar





### You will need:

Scissors Glue stick Colouring pens Coloured paper



#### How to:



1 Cut the paper into strips. About 5cm x 21cm. Arrange colours in rainbow order, like this.



4 Once you've looped all the strips together, you will have a paper chain like this!



2 Start with the red strip. Loop and glue it together. Next loop the orange through the red.



Make some wings by folding a piece of paper into a fan.
Cut out eyes and antennae.



3 Continue looping the strips, following the order of the colours of the rainbow.



6 Glue the eyes and antennae onto the caterpillar. Add the wings to make it into a butterfly!


## **Munch-crunch-counting**

How many leaves have been nibbled? Can you spot the hungry caterpillar cocoon?




# **Counting butterflies**
