



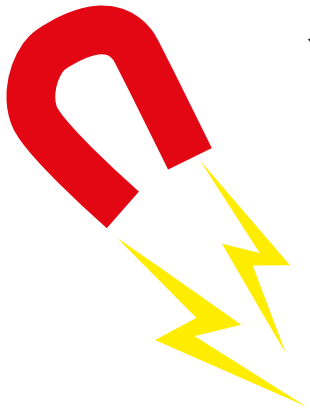

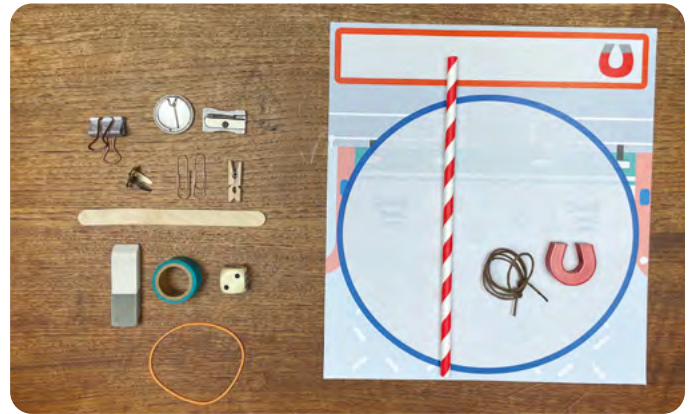
# Let's make a magnetic sorting game

This is how metal is sorted in a recycling plant



## You will need:

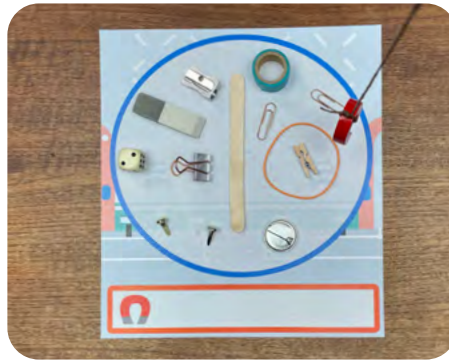
- Some metal objects
- Some non-metal objects
- Straw or stick
- String
- Mini magnet
- A sorting area



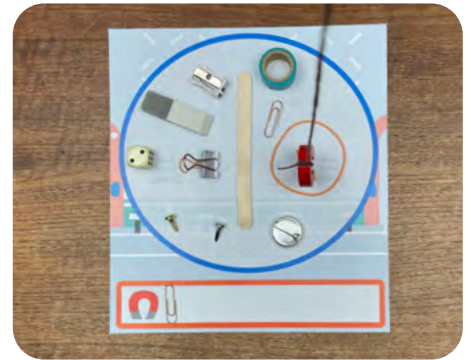
## How to:



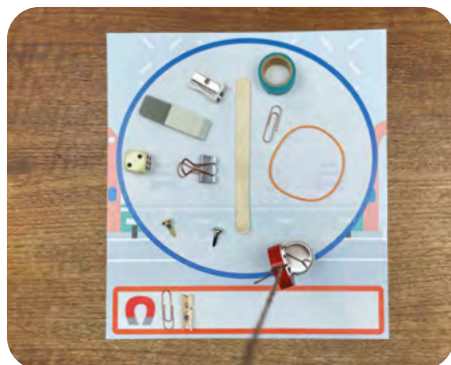
- 1** Attach the magnet to the straw with a piece of string.



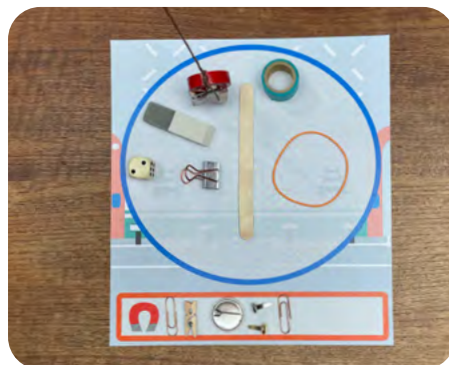
- 2** Start by placing all the objects in the blue sorting area.



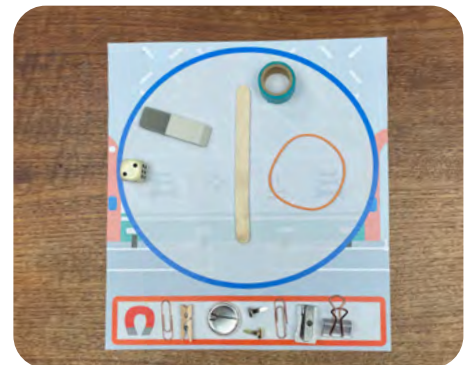
- 3** Using your magnet, hover over objects. Metal objects will be attracted to the magnet.



- 4** When you catch a metal object put it in the space below.



- 5** Which ones don't get attracted?



- 6** Keep going until you have sorted all the metal objects from the non metal ones.

# MAGAZINE BOX FILE



**You will need:**  
big cereal packet  
(750g), glue,  
scissors, ruler, pens,  
OKIDO magazine  
and colourful paper.



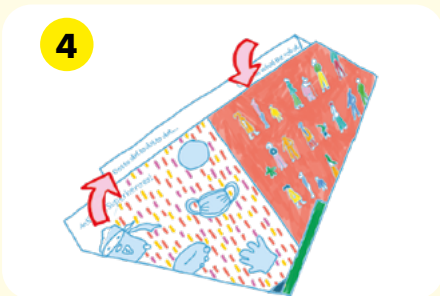
1 Cut the top off,  
leaving 22cm of  
the box.



2 Measure 15 cm  
from one edge  
and 10 cm from  
the bottom. Draw  
a line and cut.



3 Colour in some  
Okidoodle  
sheets - you'll need  
at least two.



4 Now 'wrap' the box with  
your Okidoodle sheets  
and glue to fix in place.



5 Keep sticking until all the  
sides are covered.



6 You can add 'OKIDO' to the  
front and back - either by  
cutting it out or writing it  
yourself!

gin to grow!

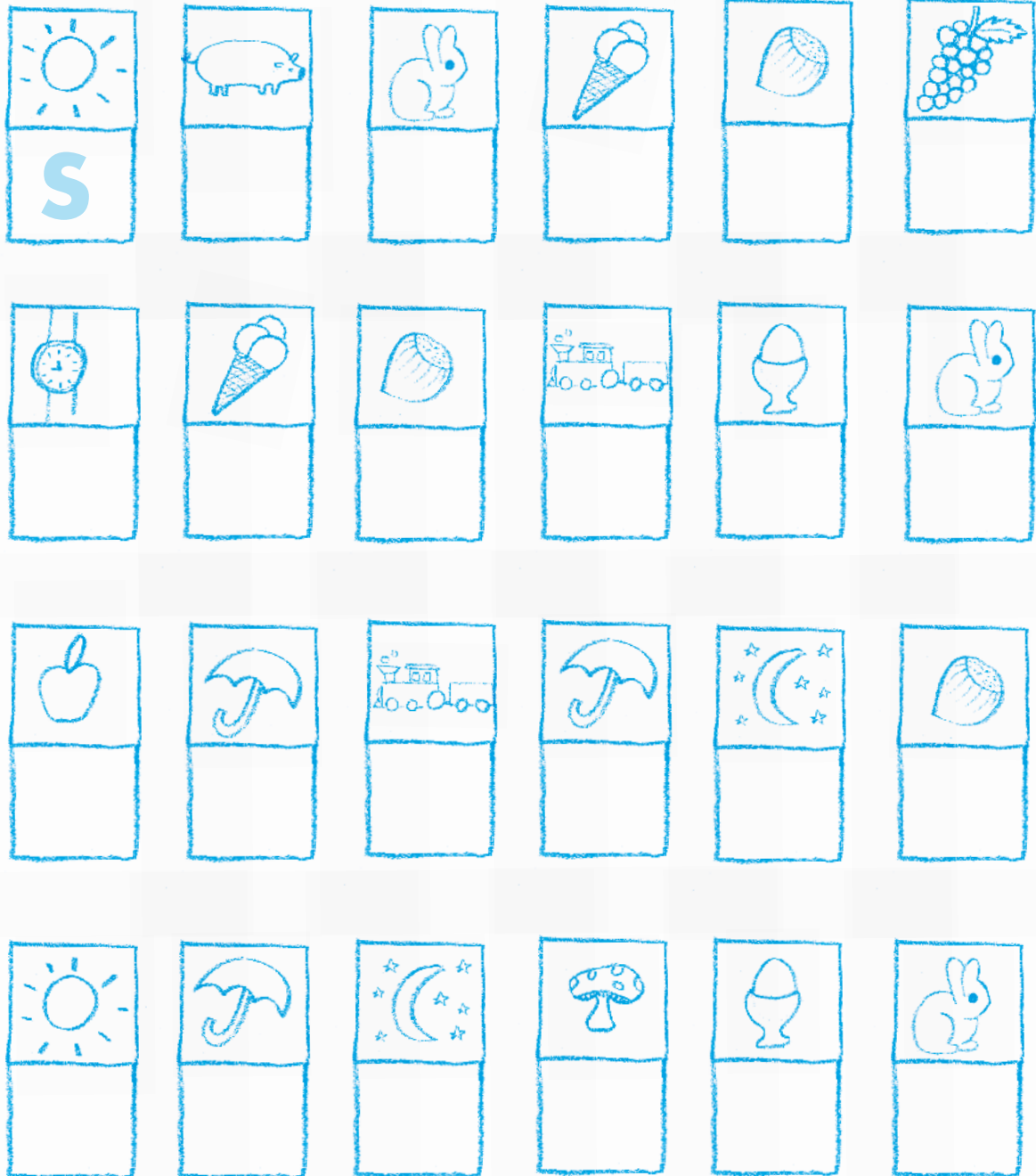

Then draw the insects that live on the plants!





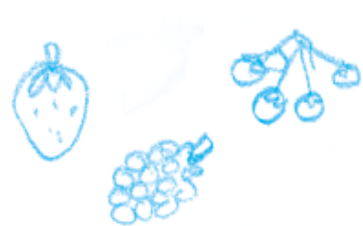
